

EVACUATION ALERT
Munro Lake Wildfire
District of Peachland
09/29/2025 at 1200 hours

An Evacuation Alert has been issued by the Regional District of Central Okanagan Emergency Operations Centre (EOC) due to the Munro Lake Wildfire.

Because of the potential danger to life and health, the District of Peachland has issued an **Evacuation Alert** for the following areas:

- 5440 to 5463 McDougald Rd
- 5357 to 5495 Pierce St
- 5379 and 5436 Princeton Avenue

A Map of the Evacuation Alert area is attached. Note that the Evacuation Alert area was previously on an Evacuation Order.

An Evacuation Alert has been issued to prepare you to evacuate your premises or property should it be found necessary. Residents will be given as much advance notice as possible prior to evacuation; however, you may receive limited notice due to changing conditions.

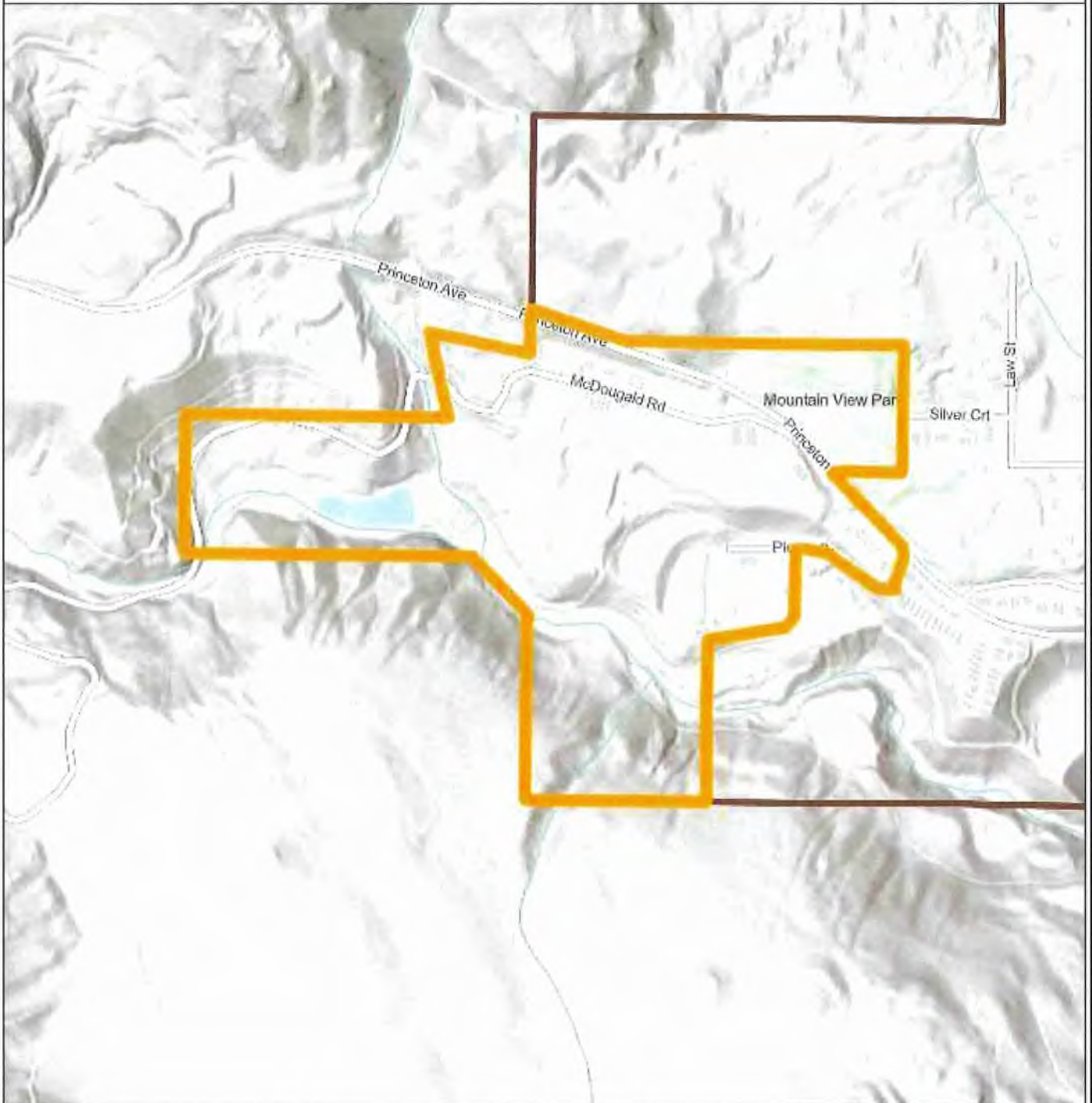
WHAT YOU SHOULD DO

- Locate all household members and designate a meeting area outside the area, should an Evacuation Order be called while separated.
- Pack essential items such as government-issued ID, medications, eyeglasses, valuable papers (e.g. insurance, credit, and mortgage information), immediate care needs for dependents and, if time and space permits, keepsakes for quick departure if necessary.
- Pack a minimum of one week's worth of supplies including food, water, toiletries, and weather appropriate clothing.
- Prepare to move disabled persons, children and/or neighbours, if assistance is needed.
- Prepare to take pets with you and move livestock to a safe area, if possible.
- Arrange transportation for all your household members. Fill the gas tanks of personal vehicles.
- Arrange accommodation for all your household members, if possible.
- Follow the guidance of the [Public Health Officer](#) and the [BC Centre for Disease Control](#) (BC CDC).
