

EVACUATION ALERT
Kalamoir Park Wildfire
City of West Kelowna
06/16/2026 at 1830 hours

An Evacuation Alert has been issued by the Regional District of Central Okanagan Emergency Operations Centre (EOC) due to immediate danger to life safety caused by wildfire.

Because of the potential danger to life and health, the City of West Kelowna has issued an **Evacuation Alert** for the following areas:

- Alice Road
- Benedick Road
- 2660 - 2699 Campbell Road
- Casa Loma Road
- Casa Palmero Drive
- 2919 -3088 Collens Hill Road
- Kalamoir Park
- Lakeridge Road
- Lakeview Road
- Lucinde Road
- Weatherhill Road

A Map of Evacuation Alert area is attached.

An Evacuation Alert has been issued to prepare you to evacuate your premises or property should it be found necessary. Residents will be given as much advance notice as possible prior to evacuation; however, you may receive limited notice due to changing conditions.

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO

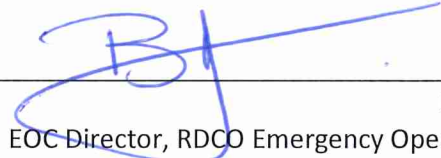
- Locate all household members and designate a meeting area outside the area, should an Evacuation Order be called while separated.
- Pack essential items such as government-issued ID, medications, eyeglasses, valuable papers (e.g. insurance, credit, and mortgage information), immediate care needs for dependents and, if time and space permits, keepsakes for quick departure if necessary.
- Pack a minimum of one week's worth of supplies including food, water, toiletries, and weather appropriate clothing.
- Prepare to move disabled persons, children and/or neighbours, if assistance is needed.
- Prepare to take pets with you and move livestock to a safe area, if possible.
- Arrange transportation for all your household members. Fill the gas tanks of personal vehicles.
- Arrange accommodation for all your household members, if possible.
- Create an ESS profile on the provincial [Evacuee Registration & Assistance \(ERA\) Tool](https://ess.gov.bc.ca) at ess.gov.bc.ca Persons who have a BC Services Card may be eligible to receive an E Transfer using

the [BC Services Card App](#).

- Follow the guidance of the [Public Health Officer](#) and the [BC Centre for Disease Control](#) (BC CDC).
- Wait for an Evacuation Order to be issued before evacuating.

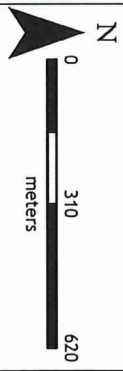
