

EVACUATION ORDER
Drought Hill Wildfire
District of Peachland
2025-07-30 at 16:15 Hours

Pursuant to Section 77(1) of the *Emergency and Disaster Management Act*, an **Evacuation Order** has been issued by the Regional District of Central Okanagan Emergency Operations Centre (EOC) due to immediate danger to life safety caused by the wildfire.

Members of the RCMP and other applicable agencies will be expediting this action.

The Evacuation Order is in effect for the following areas within District of Peachland:

- Clarence Road
- 5078, 5089, 5091, 5093, and 5101 Cousins Place
- 5019, 5039, 5049, 5095, 5102, 5103, 5105, 5107, 5109, 5111, 5113, 5115 and Cousins Road
- Greata Road
- 3599 Highway 97

- 5031 Lang Court
- Lornell Crescent
- Lornell Court
- 5030, 5070, 5090 Mackinnon Road
- MacNeill Court
- Morrison Crescent
- Morrison Court
- Morrison Place
- Shaw Road
- Sutherland Road
- East side of Trepanier Bench Road including odd addresses 5149 – 5335 Trepanier Bench Road
- Walker Road

YOU MUST LEAVE THE AREA IMMEDIATELY

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO:

- Create an ESS profile at: [Evacuee Registration & Assistance \(ERA\) Tool](#) at ess.gov.bc.ca or at an ESS Muster / Reception Centre Peachland Community Centre at 4450 6th Street.
- If you need transportation assistance from the area, advise the person providing this notice.
- Shut off all gas and electrical appliances, other than refrigerators and freezers.
- Close all windows and doors.
- Close gates (latch) but do not lock.



- Gather all household members and, if you have room, take a neighbour or someone needing transportation. Do not use more vehicles than you have to.
- Take critical items (medicine, purse, wallet, and keys) and a minimum of one week's worth of supplies including food, water, toiletries, and weather appropriate clothing only if they are immediately available. Take pets in pet kennels or on leash.
- Do not use the telephone unless you need emergency service.
