

EVACUATION ORDER
Munro Lake Wildfire
District of Peachland
09/25/2025 at 1800 Hours

Pursuant to Section 77(1) of the *Emergency and Disaster Management Act*, an **Evacuation Order** has been issued by the Regional District of Central Okanagan Emergency Operations Centre (EOC) due to immediate danger to life safety caused by the Munro Lake Wildfire.

Members of the RCMP and other applicable agencies will be expediting this action.

The Evacuation Order is in effect for the following areas within the District of Peachland:

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO:

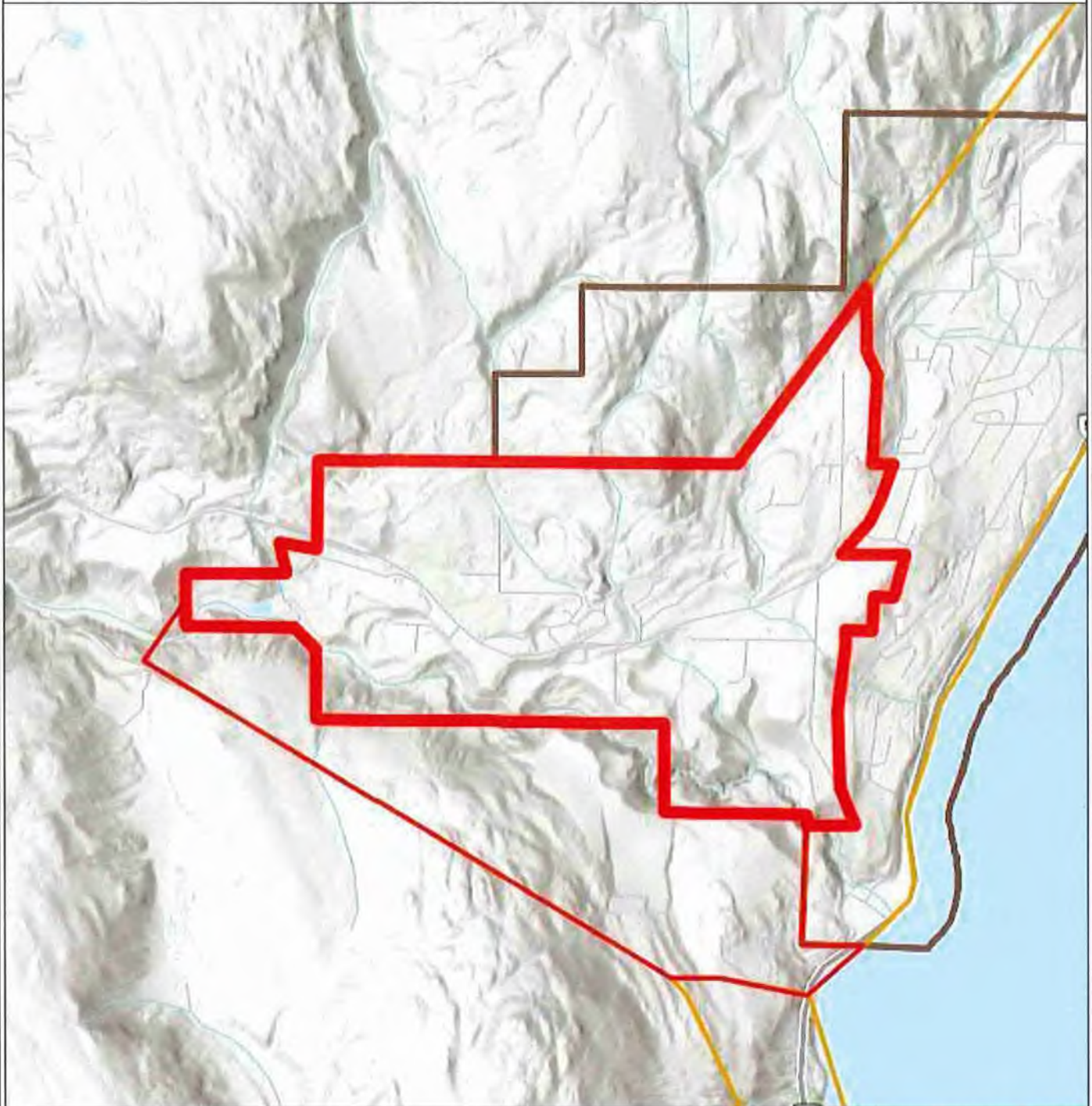
- Create an ESS profile at: [Evacuee Registration & Assistance \(ERA\) Tool](#) at ess.gov.bc.ca or at an ESS Muster / Reception Centre at the Peachland Community Centre at 4450 6th Street, Peachland.
- If you need transportation assistance from the area, advise the person providing this notice.
- Shut off all gas and electrical appliances, other than refrigerators and freezers.
- Close all windows and doors.
- Close gates (latch) but do not lock.
- Gather all household members and, if you have room, take a neighbour or someone needing transportation. Do not use more vehicles than you have to.
- Take critical items (medicine, purse, wallet, and keys) and a minimum of one week's worth of supplies including food, water, toiletries, and weather appropriate clothing only if they are immediately available. Take pets in pet kennels or on leash.
- Do not use the telephone unless you need emergency service.
