

EVACUATION ORDER
Bald Range Wildfire
Regional District of Central Okanagan
2026-08-07 at 20:00 Hours

Pursuant to [Section 77(1) of the *Emergency and Disaster Management Act*, an **Evacuation Order** has been issued by the Regional District of Central Okanagan Emergency Operations Centre (EOC) due to immediate danger to life safety caused by wildfire.

Members of the RCMP and other applicable agencies will be expediting this action.

The Evacuation Order is in effect for the following areas within Regional District of Central Okanagan:

- 7210 Brent Road to 7100 Brent Road
- 7280 HWY 97S to 6801 HWY 97S
- 307 Log Chute Road to 303 Log Chute Road

A map of the evacuation area is attached.

YOU MUST LEAVE THE AREA IMMEDIATELY

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO:

- Create an ESS profile at: Evacuee Registration & Assistance (ERA) Tool at ess.gov.bc.ca or at an ESS Muster / Reception Centre Reception Centre Reception Centre at Westbank Lions Community Centre, 2466 Main St. West Kelowna, BC V4T 1Z1.
- Shut off all gas and electrical appliances, other than refrigerators and freezers.
- Close all windows and doors.
- Close gates (latch) but do not lock.
- Gather all household members and, if you have room, take a neighbour or someone needing transportation. Do not use more vehicles than you have to.
- Take critical items (medicine, purse, wallet, and keys) and a minimum of one week's worth of supplies including food, water, toiletries, and weather appropriate clothing only if they are immediately available. Take pets in pet kennels or on leash.
- Do not use the telephone unless you need emergency service.
- Follow the guidance of the Public Health Officer and the BC Centre for Disease Control
